Our initiatives include

- Develop a whole school approach to teaching English (literacy)
- Develop a whole school approach to teaching Maths (numeracy)
- Provide education for parents of Early Years students to support the development of early literacy and numeracy skills at home
- Upskill graduate teacher to develop a deeper understanding of the effective use of data (Early Start, PM reading, Maths Assessment Tools, Words Their Way and writing samples) to inform five weekly 'collaborative inquiries' in literacy and numeracy to close the gaps in identified student achievement
- Embed student learning walls in classroom practice and foster assessment literate students
